Pope Francis: 'Abortion is more than a problem. Abortion is homicide.'

January 23, 2022 WASHINGTON — President Joe Biden pledged to defend a so-called right to abortion and reaffirmed his commitment to the widespread availability of the procedure in a Jan. 22 statement marking the anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*, the landmark 1973 decision that legalized abortion nationwide.

"The constitutional right established in *Roe v. Wade* nearly 50 years ago today is under assault as never before," reads the statement, which was co-signed by Vice President Kamala Harris. "It is a right we believe should be codified into law, and we pledge to defend it with every tool we possess. We are deeply committed to protecting access to health care, including reproductive health care—and to ensuring that this country is not pushed backwards on women's equality," the statement continues.

The statement was released one day after tens of thousands of pro-life advocates gathered in Washington for the annual March for Life. Biden and Harris condemned efforts by prolife lawmakers to enact restrictions on abortion, saying that "in Texas, Mississippi, and many other states around the country, access to reproductive health care is under attack." "These state restrictions constrain the freedom of all women," they wrote, adding that such restrictions are "particularly devastating for those who have fewer options and fewer resources, such as those in underserved communities, including communities of color and many in rural areas." In addition to support of codifying a right to an abortion throughout the entirety of a pregnancy, Biden and Harris wrote that they will "continue to work with Congress on the Women's Health Protection Act."

The Women's Health Protection Act would establish "a statutory right for health care professionals to provide abortion and the right for their patients to receive care, free from medically unnecessary restrictions that single out abortion care." If passed, the bill would also eliminate requirements including mandatory waiting periods and ultrasounds before the procedure can be performed. Biden and Harris wrote that it is important to "ensure that our daughters and granddaughters have the same fundamental rights that their mothers and grandmothers fought for and won on this day, 49 years ago."

It's a solemn day in America. 49 years ago, the Supreme Court manufactured a "right" to kill an unborn baby – abortion. What was murder, became legal – a supposed constitutional right found NOWHERE in the Constitution itself. More than 62 million babies have lost their lives in the wake of Roe v. Wade. An earth-shattering report shows that abortion is now responsible for 42% of all deaths worldwide. But right now we have the BIGGEST opportunity in a generation to over-turn Roe, defeat abortion, and save countless babies at the Supreme Court. But President Biden is pulling out all the stops for the abortion industry, defending abortion at the Supreme Court and forcing you to pay for abortions with your tax dollars. The ACLJ and YOU are needed now more than ever for the lives of unborn babies. We are the last line of defense in court. THIS is the moment. Let's make this the LAST anniversary of Roe.

The truth is, pro-abortion politicians like President Joe Biden (D), U.S. House Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-CA), and U.S. Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY) are scared. They've threatened to abolish the Senate filibuster, pack the U.S. Supreme Court *(to nullify President Trump's appointments)*, force taxpayer funding of all abortion through the repeal of the Hyde Amendment, and codify *Roe v. Wade* into law...But their entire radical pro-abortion agenda will come crashing down if they lose their razor thin majorities.
