

Our History

In 1940, there were about six Catholic families in Rutherford County. Each Sunday they traveled to Saint Mary's in Shelby for Mass. In time, construction began on the mission parish Church of the Immaculate Conception in Forest City, and the church was dedicated on September 15, 1950. In the summer of 1969, our first resident pastor was installed.


For a short period of time, Immaculate Conception reverted back to a mission parish, but not for long. We regained our Parish status in the summer of 1972. The parish continued to grow, and in December 1978 we dedicated our Rectory/Parish Hall complex.

As the years went on, we purchased adjacent properties that would be needed for continued growth. The groundbreaking ceremony for our new church was in 2009, and our new church, built in the Gothic style, was dedicated by Bishop Jugis on October 13, 2010, the anniversary of the miracle of the sun and final apparition at Fatima of Our Lady of the Rosary. Since that time, the magnificent stained glass windows, our sanctuary mural the *Theophany of the Passion*, and other artwork has been added that helps to bring the viewer's mind to God in prayer.


Our grounds have experienced changes over the years as well. Angels grace the road entrance, a bronze crucifix is there for the traveler, outside stations of the cross are available for a short pilgrimage, and Muirdach's Cross is available for history lessons on our faith.

Thanks to the prayers, work and generosity of our parishioners, Immaculate Conception Roman Catholic Church, now numbering over registered 280 families, continues to grow not just in size, but in Faith.
